



STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT

This code of conduct sets out the responsibilities of students and the school's expectations for behaviour. These responsibilities have been aligned with the school's four core values.

At Kerry Street, we aim to provide an environment in which everyone feels safe and welcome. Our students have the right to feel like they belong and we support that by demonstrating mutual respect and encouraging success.



As a student at Kerry Street you have a responsibility to:

- respect and support others at all times;
- act in a manner that is safe for yourself and others;
- support all members of the community and actively avoid participating in harassment, bullying, exclusion, intimidation, discrimination or aggressive behaviour;
- use non-violent communication methods to resolve conflict;
- seek assistance from an adult if you are unable to solve a problem on your own;
- listen to and consider the opinions of others;
- be considerate and respect that others may have different learning needs; and
- use all school resources safely and appropriately as directed by teachers, including technology resources like iPads and laptops.



As a student at Kerry Street you have a responsibility to:

- cooperate in the classroom so that everyone can learn;
- work to the best of your ability;
- ask for assistance when needed; and
- participate in all aspects of the curriculum and programs.

- collaborate and negotiate to find fair solutions;
- participate in all whole school and class clean up activities;

- demonstrate respect for all community members using courtesy and appropriate language, including when in the broader community during school time; and
- participate in school sustainability and waste wise reduction practices.
